MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for our missionary team living among in a small Eastern European country. Since security is an issue, we are highlighting the work on the field and our missionaries as a team instead of individually.

Global Partners has a growing team of workers in a small country in Eastern Europe. Our team's vision is to see God's Kingdom change communities through a prayer-led disciple making movement as local followers of Jesus discover Scripture, obey God's commands, and engage together as the body of Christ. We are currently in between the phase of establishing relationships and discipling known believers. We continue to face a variety of challenges that seem to come one after another; from team health issues, living visa challenges, and a cultural taboo of talking about faith issues or changing one's beliefs. As we continue to rely on the power of prayer, we are seeking to grow in partnership as a team, anticipating a season of intense ministry, transition, and hosting short-term mission teams and interns.

Prayer Points from the Eastern Europe Mission Team:

- Pray for wisdom in handling the challenges before us. Pray that we would lean into God's strength and peace.
- Pray that we would be able to engage new groups of lost people.
- Pray for us to be intentional about inviting people to take the next step of faith in their journeys.

WHAT IS A PASSOVER SEDER?

The Passover Seder is a meal that usually takes place on the first night of the Feast of Passover. It is commemorated on the anniversary of the Israelites' miraculous exodus from Egyptian slavery more than 3000 years ago.

This is the same kind of feast meal that Jesus celebrated with His disciples during what we call The Last Supper. It is also where we get our tradition of communion.

The meal includes readings, special foods, singing, and other Passover traditions.
