GLOBAL PRAYER-NET

SPECIAL PRAYER FOCUS: HAITI

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for our missionaries to Haiti and to the Haitian Wesleyans throughout Haiti:

Global Partners has evacuated our full missionary team serving in Haiti. Escalating unrest in Haiti required this evacuation. Evacuations began last week. No team member has been harmed.

"This is a desperate time for the citizens of Haiti, and while our hearts and prayers are with them, the situation had become unsafe and without any indication of stopping," said Global Partners Executive Director Dennis Jackson. "After focused prayer and dialog with our Global Partners Haiti leadership team and local contacts, we sought and followed the counsel of our international security consultants in making the decision to evacuate our missionaries.

"Another influence on our decision to evacuate," added Dr. Jackson, "is that Haiti's ambassador to the U.S. was recalled. When we were told that the U.S. State Department was evacuating all non-essential personnel from Haiti, we felt we had to act to protect our team members." On February 14, the U.S. Embassy raised the security threat in Haiti to a level four (high).

General Superintendent Wayne Schmidt is asking The Wesleyan Church to pray for Haiti, its political situation, the men, women, and children who live there, church leadership and Global Partner members who had to separate from their co-laborers and friends.

According to Greg Edmonds, Global Partners missionary and Haiti mission director, the Haitian staff in Haiti depend on the funds generated by short-term mission teams to pay their salaries. Mission team travel to Haiti has been cancelled through March 15, and this date will likely be extended with no definite end to the unrest. Food is scarce on La Gonave, and the food that is available has become very expensive. People are hungry and desperate!

Help our Haitian brothers and sister in their time of need. Give to provide assistance to the Haitian staff of the Wesleyan Mission in Haiti (including guesthouses on La Gonave & Ortlip Ministry Center).
