MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Tom and Lydia Hines, Hispanic Ministry Consulting.

Since 1979, Tom and Lydia Hines have served with Global Partners in Honduras, Costa Rica, El Salvador, and Ecuador. Their roles have included teaching, administration, church planting, leadership training, prison ministry, and development of CREA (Centro de Recursos en Español para las Américas), an online resource center. Currently, they are on special assignment with Global Partners doing Hispanic Ministry Consulting with districts and individual churches in North America. They desire to amplify the mission of the church by facilitating understanding, communication, and cooperation between cultures.

Their life verse is John 15:16, “You have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you and ordained you, that you should go and bring forth fruit, fruit that will remain.”

Prayer Points from Tom and Lydia Hines:

- Pray for the 14 Hispanic leaders that are part of a new mentoring group from Greater Ohio District, as well as the six people who signed up for individual ministry coaching.
- Pray for us as we travel from June to October to do our partnership development. Pray as we build up our prayer team. Also pray for an increase in giving to our ministry in order to meet our faith promise goal.
