## **GLOBAL PRAYER-NET**

### **MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS**

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Chris and Wendy England, missionaries to Croatia.

Chris and Wendy have been ministering as missionaries in Croatia since 2005. They both experienced short-term mission opportunities as young people and then together after marriage.

Colossians 1:28-29 (NIV) speaks to the Englands about their call to ministry and missions: *"We proclaim him, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone perfect in Christ. To this end I labor, struggling with all his energy, which so powerfully works in me."*

Their desire is to model Christ to the people of Croatia, share His transforming power, connect them with other believers, equip them to grow in their walk with Christ, and challenge them to discover Christ's call to ministry. Chris and Wendy have three children: Kyler ('99), Caden ('04), and Abby ('07).

### **Prayer Points from Chris and Wendy England:**

- Pray that God would give our ministry team vision and clarity as we focus on the development of ministry in Croatia.
- Pray that our national church leaders would continue to be rooted in Christ. Pray for wisdom and strength as they seek to raise up their own families in the Lord and to minister in the church. Pray for them as they share God's truth and hope.
- Pray for guidance and perseverance as we pray for and connect with individuals in our community. Pray that we would connect with people who are spiritually hungry and searching for God.
- Pray that God would provide the funds necessary to complete the Živa Nada Wesleyan Church Ministry Center. The center will be used for ministry and as a hub for developing leaders and missionaries. Approximately \$20,000 is needed for the project.
- Pray for our son Kyler as he transitions to college in the US this summer. Pray for a healthy transition for him. Pray for us as we adjust to living halfway around the world away from him.

# WHEN YOU DON'T SEE RESULTS

LUKE 5:1-11

*“One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, with the people crowding around him and listening to the word of God, he saw at the water’s edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.” (vs. 1-3)*

*“When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, ‘Now launch out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch.’ Simon answered, ‘Master, we’ve worked hard all night and haven’t caught anything.’” (vs. 4-5a)*

## WHAT TO DO IN A DISCOURAGING SITUATION

*“Jesus got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.” (vs. 3)*

*“When Jesus had finished speaking, he said to Simon, ‘Now launch out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch.’ Simon answered, ‘Master, we’ve worked hard all night and haven’t caught anything.’” (vs. 4-5a)*

*“Simon answered, ‘Master, we’ve worked hard all night and haven’t caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets.’” (vs. 5)*

WHEN: *“Now launch out”*

WHAT: *“let down your nets”*

WHERE: *“into deep water”*

*“When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break! So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink!” (vs. 6-7)*

## THE REAL LESSON

*“Then Jesus said to Simon, ‘Don’t be afraid; from now on you will catch men.’ So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.” (vs. 10-11)*
