MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Perry Hubbard, missionary to Panama.

Perry Hubbard, along with Nancy, his wife, began their missionary service with Global Partners in 1986. They served in Sierra Leone, Papua New Guinea, and Guyana. In 2008 they relocated to Panama where Perry currently lives and ministers.

Perry serves as the Interim Director of JIBACAM, the missions board for Ibero-America. He travels throughout Latin America presenting seminars on missions and developing materials to promote missions.

Perry assists in the work of The Wesleyan Church of Panama and is involved in the training of pastors and in the local men's ministry. Nancy gave leadership to the hospitality ministry of the church and tutored English until she passed on to her eternal home in 2018.

Prayer Points from Perry Hubbard:

- Pray for the cross-cultural training event to be held in Trinidad on July 6-20. There will be 16 participants from six countries who will learn how to enter, live, and serve in another culture.
- Pray for the mission coordinators training planned for November 1-4. Training will include preparing key leaders to lead their regions in teaching churches about missions, to send missionaries, and to equip those who are called to missions.
- Pray for the JIBACAM congress that is scheduled to be held on November 6-8. The focus is learning how to reach the Muslim world. Pray for the guest lecturer, Fouad Masri of Crescent Project.
- Pray for the first meeting of the Ibero-America Regional Conference scheduled to be held on November 4-5. Pray for God to anoint this time of vision development and planning for the years ahead.

Mark 6:45-52

“Immediately Jesus made his disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to Bethsaida, while he dismissed the crowd. After leaving them, he went up alone on a mountainside to pray. When evening came, the boat was in the middle of the lake, and he was alone on land. He saw the disciples straining at the oars, because the wind was against them. About the fourth watch of the night he went out to them, walking on the lake. He was about to pass by them, but when they saw him walking on the lake, they thought he was a ghost! They cried out, because they all saw him and were terrified. Immediately he spoke to them and said, ‘Take courage! It is I. Don’t be afraid.’ Then he climbed into the boat with them, and the wind died down. They were completely amazed, for they had not understood about the loaves; their hearts were hardened.”
