Then in 2010 she began serving in a squatter community that is home to more than 100 orphans and vulnerable children. Global Partners appointed Angie to serve as a long-term missionary in Guyana in 2013.

Angie's vision is to develop leaders of all ages and to give the vulnerable a voice. She teaches mission-minded nationals at the Wesleyan Bible College and brings light to those who live in a community of shadowy oppression.
