MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Chris and Melissa George, missionaries to Australia.

Chris and Melissa, along with their three children, Makayla '03, Dawson '05, and Brayden '09, have been ministering in Perth, Western Australia, since 2004. Australia is a spiritually dry society that is largely unchurched. There is a need for a spiritual awakening so that people would become aware of spiritual things and would begin questioning and searching for truth. Chris and Melissa strive to stimulate spiritual awareness and share the good news of the gospel with their community. They do this through church planting and community engagement. They desire to love their community so that the community will see the love of Christ.

Chris serves as the pastor of the Landsdale Community Wesleyan Methodist Church and is the zone coordinator looking after the pastors of Western Australia. Melissa serves in the local church and is also the district and national director of children's ministries. Their desire is to see God move in mighty ways throughout the Wesleyan Methodist Church of Australia.

Prayer Points from Chris and Melissa George:

- Pray that we would be able to identify leaders in the Australian church as we put into place strategies to help them develop.
- Pray that the families we connect with would be interested and enthusiastic about being disciplined and then discipling others.
- Pray that new communities across Western Australia would be identified as locations for new church plants. Pray for the leaders to lead these churches.
- Pray for new and exciting ways for the church to engage with the community so people would have an chance to hear the gospel.
- Pray for our family as we travel in North America on partnership development from August 2019 through January 2020. Pray that God would renew the passion in our team to see work completed.
- Pray that we reach our goal of 100 new prayer partners, \$3,000 in new monthly commitments, and \$22,000 into our account balance.
