BIBLE READING CHALLENGE

How to Read the Bible

Step #1: Choose a productive time of day to have your devotional time with God. Begin by praying, asking the Holy Spirit to grant you uninterrupted time and insightful understanding of God's Word. Read 2 or 3 of the Bible chapters assigned to each day. If you miss a day, the weekends provide for 'catch up' readings/journaling.

Step #2: Using the acrostic S.O.A.P., write four things into your Journal.

- S:** a specific Bible verse which stands out to you.
- O:** a general observation about what the Bible passage is saying.
- A:** an application of the Biblical truth to your present life/situation.
- P:** a 1 or 2 sentence prayer to God, concerning what is most on your heart/mind today.

We are working towards a 3rd well.

World Hope is sending our money to Sierra Leone to begin the process for a Deep Borehole Well. Each well will provide approximately 600—1000 people clean water. It will take up to 6 months for the well to be useable by the villagers. Each village forms a committee, with the help of World Hope, to know how to maintain their well and develop a plan for replacements parts. This enables the village to have a functional well for the long-term. Geo studies are first done to ensure a successful drill and a long term well. When the drilling process is complete, a sign is placed at the well with Trenton Wesleyan's name on it. World Hope takes the opportunity to show "The Jesus Film" to the villagers when the project is completed. We will receive a report giving us GPS coordinates, information about the village and a picture of the well.

Deep Borehole Wells

- do not dry up during dry season
- last longer and do not contaminate easily
- lowers risk of attacks on women and children from having to walk for water
- allows for children to go to school when they don't have to fetch water every day
- provides agricultural growth, healthy farming and raising of livestock
- decreases death rate of babies and young children
